Gambling Addiction Counseling Training Series

Recovery Resources, in collaboration with the Ohio Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services and the Ohio Lottery, presents the 2013 Gambling Addiction and Prevention Training series.

Stage I: Foundations in Disordered Gambling

Foundations in Disordered Gambling is a two day training intended for clinicians who are new to disordered gambling. This training will increase the participants' knowledge and understanding of the disease of gambling addiction and prepare the practicing clinician to work with problem and pathological gamblers and their families. (No prerequisite required)

Stage II: Treating the Disordered Gambler

Presenter: Dr. Heather Chapman, Ph. D., NCGC-II-BACC

Treating the Disordered Gambler is a two day training that will provide clinicians with 12 hours of gambling specific education. This phase of training is designed for the clinician preparing to treat disordered gamblers. During this training, clinicians will gain a better understanding of treating gambling addiction through Cognitive Behavioral Therapy and Motivational Interviewing techniques. Participants will discuss case reviews, participate in role plays, and write treatment plans. Participants will also discuss disordered gambling as a co-occurring disorder.

Prerequisite: Foundations in Disordered Gambling or previous 12 hour gambling counseling training

Gambling Ethics and Case Conceptualization

In this two day training participants will gain further knowledge and experience in treating disordered gamblers. Participants will take a hands on approach by reviewing case studies. Best practices used to treat gambling addiction will be discussed. This training will provide the required 3 hours of ethics needed for the Ohio gambling credential.

Beyond Screening: The impact of gambling on recovery

In this workshop we will explore the evidence and research that supports the need to integrate the topics of gambling and problem gambling into mental health and substance abuse treatment. We will practice techniques to integrate gambling issues into psychosocial assessments and to use motivational strategies in helping clients define the role of gambling in their recovery.
